## Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in blue (2 skeins)
- Worsted weight yarn in green (1 skein)
- US size 8 (5 mm) knitting needles
- Yarn needle

## Gauge

4 stitches per inch in stockinette stitch

## **Abbreviations**

- k: knit
- p: purl
- st: stitch
- rep: repeat
- CO: cast on
- BO: bind off

## **Pattern**

### **Tea Cosy Base**

CO 60 sts with blue yarn.

Row 1: K all sts.

Row 2: P all sts.

Rep Rows 1-2 for a total of 12 inches.

BO all sts.

### **Bluebells**

CO 4 sts with blue yarn.

Row 1: K all sts.

Row 2: K2, inc 1 st, k2.

Row 3: K all sts.

Row 4: K2, inc 1 st, k3.

Rep Rows 3-4 for a total of 6 inches.

BO all sts.

## **Leaves**

CO 3 sts with green yarn.

Row 1: K all sts.

Row 2: K1, inc 1 st, k1.

Row 3: K all sts.

Row 4: K2, inc 1 st, k1.

Rep Rows 3-4 for a total of 4 inches.

BO all sts.

## **Assembly**

Sew the bluebells to the tea cosy base, spacing them evenly around the edge.

Sew the leaves to the bluebells, one on each side.

Tie a ribbon around the top of the tea cosy to secure it.

## **Tips**

- If you want your tea cosy to be a different size, adjust the number of stitches you CO for the base.
- You can use any color of yarn you like for the bluebells and leaves.
- If you are a beginner, don't be afraid to ask for help from a more experienced knitter.

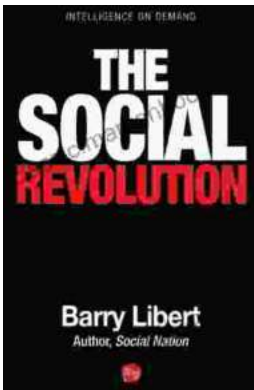
